The Future of Food

Because the world's population is growing, people are now thinking
about how we will be able to make or grow enough food for everyone in the
future. [1] For example, two *billion people in the world already
eat *insects, but more people may start eating them because they are easier
to produce than farm animals. [2] Sea plants may become a more
popular food in the future for the same reasons.
Scientists are looking at new ways of making food, too. They have
found a way to grow meat from animal *cells - the smallest living parts of
animals. To do this, scientists take cells from an animal and grow them into
meat in a *laboratory. Some people think that we should grow meat in this
way in the future. [3]
Some companies are also now making *GM (genetically modified) foods.
GM foods are made when scientists add DNA from other *species to food
plants like fruits and vegetables to change them. [4] Some of these
GM fruits and vegetables can grow well even when there is no rain and others
are stronger against illnesses. Because of this, some people think that GM
foods will be important in the future.
[5] They think that growing GM *crops may *damage the
environment, and they also think that eating GM foods may be bad for our
health.
